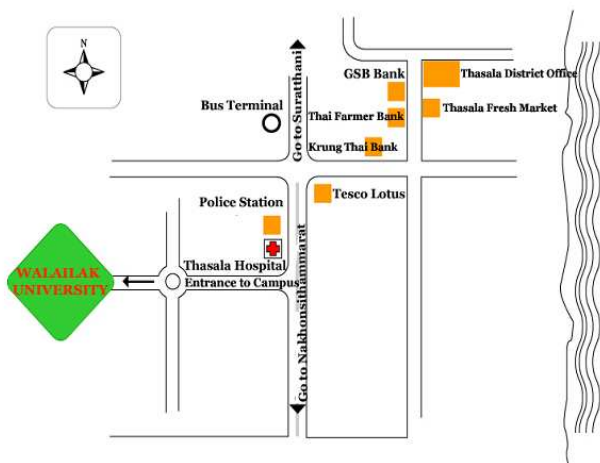


# WALAILAK UNIVERSITY

Walailak University is a residential university equipped with state-of-the-art educational facilities, services and accommodation for students and staff, located against a beautiful backdrop of mountain scenery in Thasala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province, Thailand. It was established in 1992 (officially opened in 1998)

The Walailak University comprises of more than 6,000 students and 800 staff.



## CULTURALLY RICH LOCATION NAKHON SI THAMMARAT, SOUTHERN THAILAND

Nakhon Si Thammarat is historical city, a former kingdom rich with her unique culture and traditions passed down since ancient times.

Nakhon Si Thammarat province is situated on the Gulf of Thailand and has charming marine tourist attractions as well as a beautiful natural environment including several national parks. It is 780 kilometers down south from Bangkok.

Travel within the province is easy with mini-bus service around the city. Transport to nearby provinces includes vans, taxis, buses, and trains.

There are two seasons in Southern Thailand. The rainy season is from June to January. The hot and drier season is from February to May. The average temperature is 36 Celsius, but it is slightly cooler in the rainy season.



## RESOURCES AND SUPPORTING LEARNING FACILITIES

Walailak University is more than a modern campus which provides all facilities to support teaching and learning, research and to facilitate and enrich campus life, such as:

- ◆ Fully-equipped science laboratories
- ◆ Teaching and research laboratories with state-of-the-art computer technology
- ◆ Computer Laboratories with more than 1,700 modern online computers (with Wi-Fi hi-speed wireless internet access)
- ◆ The Center for Library Resources and Educational Media uses a VTLS (Virginia Tech Library System) automated system
- ◆ Wireless Network Campus (WU Wi-Fi)
- ◆ Indoor and outdoor Sports Facilities
- ◆ 24 hours student health service

## CAREER AND COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

Cooperative Education is an educational model that systematically integrates classroom learning with practical work experience and thereby enables the students to identify and develop their potential for suitable employment to the fullest extent. It arranges work experience placements for our undergraduate students in public and private sector enterprises in Thailand as well as overseas. Each placement, lasting 3 to 4 months, so that they are well equipped with both professional knowledge and the workplace skills for their respective employment after graduation.

## DORMITORIES AND ACCOMMODATION SERVICES

The University manages 12 residential halls: 7 for female students and 5 for male students. The halls provide on-campus accommodation for about 4,560 students. Each hall of residence contains two to four bedrooms. It costs the student 2,700 – 4,800 Baht per trimester.

Another alternative for visiting guests is the multi-purpose Walailak Hospitality Center hotel provides modern and reasonably priced accommodation on campus for those who require accommodation while doing business at the University. The Center features 24 twin, single-bed rooms and 8 double-bed rooms. It costs 500 Baht/room/night.

## COSTS OF LIVING

The estimated weekly budget is approximately 3,400 Baht, including Accommodation (off-campus) 750, Food 1,050 Public Transport 350, Health costs 200, Laundry 250, Clothing & Entertainment 500, Book & Stationary 300.

The above estimates do not cover the cost of running a motor vehicle, tuition fees and will vary according to individual students' lifestyles.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

Admission to undergraduate programs is possible through three types of intake:

- ◆ A quota system for high achievers from senior high schools in all regions of Thailand. The annual quota constitutes 50% of the intake;
- ◆ Meeting the requirements of the National University Entrance Examinations organized by the Ministry of Education;
- ◆ Direct entrance examination.

Applicants for undergraduate program must complete their upper secondary education or equivalent to grade 12 in order to apply for study at a bachelor's degree. The examination is required and followed by an interview.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

- ◆ Applicants for postgraduate program must have a bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- ◆ The examination is required and followed by an interview, and meet special qualifications requirement determined by each postgraduate program committee.
- ◆ Health certificate signed by medical practitioner showing that the applicant do not have any symptoms or suffering from contagious or acute disease.
